



The Empower Wellness Screening Program is available to the public at NO COST!

Your Screening Package Includes:

- Panel C Testing that consists of a 37-component blood chemistry profile. In addition to identifying signs of heart disease and diabetes, Panel C tests for liver and kidney malfunction, and thyroid, blood, and nutrition disorders.
- Prostate Specific Antigen (PSA) Screens for signs of prostate cancer in men. (Optional; available at no cost)
- Body Mass Index BMI will be calculated if height and weight are self-reported.

1. Create a NEW account: empower.health

This is not the same registration site used for previous EHS screenings. All participants must create a new account.

2. Complete "New User" fields and enter client

You will receive an email confirmation. Verify your email to complete the registration process.

- 3. On the Dashboard, complete the optional Empower Health Assessment**
- 4. Return to the Dashboard and click "Register" to schedule an appointment for an onsite event

5. Once you have scheduled an appointment, download and print one (1) copy of you to bring to your screening (REQUIRED)

- Registration closes at NOON the business day before your event.
- · Results are available online within 5-7 business days of your event.

Class Topics

Emergency and Disaster Preparedness

Students will learn about the difference between an emergency, a disaster, and a hazard as well as what types of emergencies to be prepared for, protective actions to take, family emergency communications plans, disaster supply kits, Go Bags, and what to do during severe weather.

First Aid

A First Aid/CPR instructor will teach age appropriate basic first aid, including responsive vs. unresponsive, phoning for help, when to call 911, personal protective equipment, the importance of hand washing, finding the problem, stopping bleeding and choking.
